AP Exams:

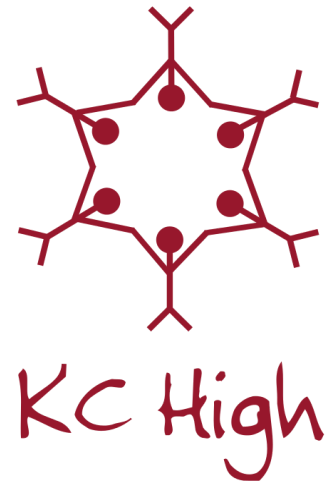

The PSAT 10 for 10th graders will be administered at the OP campus on March 3rd and the PSAT 8/9 for 8th and 9th graders will be administered on March 4th at the OP campus. The PSAT or Preliminary SAT exams measure what students are learning in school and helps determine if they are on track for high school and beyond.
